

TECHNIQUES OF MEDICAL PROCEDURES FINAL TEST: RULES AND REGULATIONS

Academic year 2023/2024

1. The final test in the subject, Techniques of Medical Procedures, will take place on the 10th of June 2024 at 4:45 PM in lecture hall no. 4, CM NCU Library Building, located at 9 Marii Skłodowskiej-Curie Street.
2. The final test consists of thirty multiple-choice or open-ended questions. In multiple-choice questions only one answer is correct.
3. The test must be completed within 20 minutes.
4. For each question answered correctly a student will receive 1 point. In order to receive a passing grade, it is necessary to score at least 18 points.
5. If the minimum number of points in the final test is not obtained, **one re-take of the test is allowed.**
6. In the case of a student failing both the initial and the re-taken final tests, the student will be considered as having failed the subject. The student may make a request under certain circumstances to the Dean asking for an additional re-test (a so-called commission examination).
7. All students are obliged to complete their final test by themselves without communicating with others. The use of any sort of aids during the examination is strictly forbidden. (e.g. phones and any other electronic devices). Any violations of this regulation will result in the student being considered to have failed the final test.
8. It is forbidden to take any photos of the test questions.
