Criteria for obtaining credit for the course

1) Final test – at the end of the semester - is the evaluation of learning the issues discussed in the lectures, tutorials and in the given literature

Rates of conversion of the percentage of correct answers into grades are as follows:

2) Tutorials

The prerequisite is to obtain at least 30 points (60% of total 50 points) from entrance tests and at least 60% of the points for the correct answers for EACH report (separately) from tutorials.

- The entrance tests will take place at the beginning of the each classes and will include the current material. The first test will be conducted during the first tutorial. Student is obliged to familiarize with the material contained in the program of the subject and prepare for classes according to the lectures and literature. There is only one term of passing the entrance tests, without possibility of improvement. Students who have not obtained the required number of points (30 points overall) take an additional test, which must take place before the exam. Failure of this additional test makes it impossible to obtain credit for the subject.
- Reports from the classes should be prepared in the form of worksheets with drawings of parasites seen under microscope during tutorials and answers for control questions. They are given by a teacher at the beginning of each tutorials and must be returned at the end of the same tutorial.
